



WOLF'S WONDERFUL WEEKEND WINDS UP WITH WHIPSTICK WIN

Wolf Heiden has capped a wonderful weekend by winning race 10 of the Bendigo Athletic Club's Cross Country season, the Rogan Family 6500 metres, held at Notley's Reserve in the Whipstick Park.

Heiden ran a time of 27.03 minutes, to hold out the fast finishing Jesse Noden & the third placed Club Secretary Mark Findlay.

Heiden picked up his new runners from club sponsors, Bicknell's Independent Sports on Saturday morning, before winning the South Bendigo Athletic Club 6500 metre race in them on Saturday afternoon and then the Bendigo Athletic Club 6500 metre race on Sunday morning.

Heiden also claimed the first prize in the Flack Advisory Veteran's Award, ahead of Mark Findlay & Austin Beamish.

Fastest Time on the day was Josh Sait in 22.43, ahead of Greg Hilson 23.24 & Jesse Noden 23.57 minutes.

Fastest Female on the circuit was Kerrieanne Hocking in 29.18, ahead of Lyn Crome 30.52 & Lucy Booker in 31.48 minutes.

Second placed Jesse Noden also claimed top points in the Mark & Liz Findlay

Under 23 award, ahead of Lachlan Knowles & Josh Sait.

First Female on handicap, taking maximum points in the Bendigo's Original Pie Shop award was overall fourth placed Lucy Booker, with Kerrieanne Hocking, second & Lyn Crome, third.

Ava Stewart, also made it two wins in two days, after also winning at the South Bendigo run on Saturday, taking out the BAC Children's 1000 metres in 5.09 minutes, ahead of the Findlay sisters, Sydney, second & Arabella, third.

Kyle Hilson ran the Fastest Time of 3.54 minutes, with Erin Hilson the Fastest Girl in 4.00 minutes.



Next week is Race 11 of the Cross Country season, the Rising Sun Hotel Feature Race over 6500 metres, valued at \$1,000, with \$500.00 going to the race winner. Despite a below par performance in the weekend's 6500 metres, Josh Nolan will go into this week's race at No.7 Reservoir at Crusoe Park, as the top selection, however many other runners are starting to fire!

Billy Makeham's 2nd placing in race 9 & Jesse Noden's 2nd place in race 10 will see them right in the mix, whilst John Rose, Mark Findlay, Lucy Booker & Jeremy Boulton are all knocking on the door for a win, but with only 2 races left, someone is going to miss out this season!

A Children's 1000 metre race will start at 10am, with the main event starting at 10.30am.

After this week's race, a social lunch will be held at the venue of the race day sponsor, the Rising Sun Hotel from 12.30pm.
