Just back from the becoming the World 400 metre Champion at the World Masters Games in Sacramento, USA, for over 60's, Kathryn Heagney showed her versatility finishing 4th overall in 24.15 minutes.

Being her first run of the season in the last race, Heagney did not qualify to score points, therefore, Lucy Booker was officially first in the Bendigo's Original Pie Shop Female section, ahead of Lyn Crome & Rhonda Schultz.


Lyn Crome was fastest female of the day in 21.54 minutes ahead of Kerrieanne Hocking & Jessica O'Hara.
