





## COLBERT CLAIMS KEL PELL CLASSIC

First year runner with the Bendigo Athletic Club Allan Colbert, has claimed race 3 of the cross country season, the Kel Pell 6500 metre handicap, held at the Bendigo Livestock Exchange in Huntly on Sunday.

Colbert showed great improvement, after finishing 21<sup>st</sup> in last week's 5000 metre

race in Mandurang.

Colbert trailed Kerrieanne Hocking for most of the race, before moving to the lead in the final kilometre, finishing in 28.20 minutes, 7 seconds clear of the second placed Greg Hilson, with Hocking holding on to be third over the line.

Last week's 5000m winner Josh

Sait recorded the fastest time of 22.34 minutes, ahead of Phil Noden 23.04 & Greg Hilson 23.37.

Hilson claimed maximum points in the RetireInvest Veterans Award, ahead of Kerrieanne Hocking & Lyn Crome.

Hocking was the Fastest Female on the course recording a time of 28.41 minutes.

In the Bendigo's Original Pie Shop Award for the top womens placings, Kerrieanne Hocking was first, Lyn Crome second and Lucy Booker gaining third placed points.



Allan Colbert also claimed the top points in the Liz & Mark Findlay Under 23 award, ahead of Jesse Noden & Josh Sait.

Matthew Noden had a good win over his younger brother Daniel in the 1km Children's Race, running a time of 4.32 minutes.

Jake Hilson finished in third place, with a time of 3.42 minutes, whilst Fastest time went to Tom Noden in 3.39.

Fastest female time went to Demi Goodall-Hoffman in 3.51 minutes. Race 4 of the BAC season will be run this Sunday over 8000 metres at Woodlands Historical Park, Bulla, in Melbourne.

The race valued at \$1600.00, will include \$800 for the winner &/or \$100 for the 1<sup>st</sup> Bendigo runner.

Incorporated into the event is the VM & HM Dreschsler 8000 metre Sealed Handicap for Bendigo runners only, which includes prizemoney of a further \$280.00.
