



LYN FIRES CROME BULLETS AT RIFLE RANGE RUN

The ultra consistent Lyn Crome was firing all the shots in the Bendigo Athletic Club's Cross Country 6500 metres held on Sunday at the Wellsford Rifle Range in Bendigo.

Crome crossed the line one minute clear of her nearest challenger, Jesse Noden, who claimed second placing in the shadows of the post from Club President Mark Stevens.

After a string of placings, Crome was unstoppable on the wet & slippery course, winning in a time of 29.31 minutes in the Schultz/Stewart Landcapping backed event.

Josh Sait ran the fastest time of the day with 22.33 minutes, ahead of Greg Hilson 23.25 & Jesse Noden third fastest in 23.56.

Fastest Female over the course was Jessica O'Hara in 27.59 minutes.

Crome, along with Jessica O'Hara & Rhonda Schultz gained the placings in the Bendigo's Original Pie Shop women's award.

The Liz & Mark Findlay Under 23 placings went to Jesse Noden, ahead of Jess O'Hara & Allan Colbert.

Crome also picked up maximum points in the RetireInvest Veteran's Award, ahead of Mark Stevens & Rod Skidmore.

Jordan Doherty won the 1000 metre Children's Race, leading all the way to win in 6.13 minutes, with Ava Stewart second & Sydney Findlay in third place.

Fastest time was recorded by Kyle Hilson in 4.40 minutes, with Amila Carlile, the fastest girl in 4.53 minutes.



Next Sunday morning's event, race 7 at No.7 Reservoir at Crusoe Park in Kangaroo Flat is set to be a very open race, as placings 2nd to 16th in this week's event were only separated by 53 seconds.

This week's Phil Noden 8000 metre event is one of the highly ranked races on the program, boasting \$350.00 1st prize.

The Children 1000 metre race will start at 10am, with the main event starting at 10.30am.
