



KERRIEANNE COLLECTS CRUSOE CASH

Kerrieanne Hocking has raced to a great victory in the Phil Noden 8000 metres, Race 7 of the Bendigo Athletic Club Cross Country season on Sunday.

Hocking, who ran 35.17 minutes for the 8km around Crusoe Park in Kangaroo Flat, grabbed the \$350.00 first prize, four seconds clear of the rapidly closing Mark Perdon, with Josh Nolan, a further 51 seconds back in third place.

Kerrieanne Hocking was also the fastest female on the day, ahead of Jessica O'Hara & Lyn Crome.

Josh Nolan had the fastest overall time of the day with 27.17 minutes, well clear of Josh Sait 29.03 & Greg Hilson 29.08 minutes.

After a series of placings this season, Hocking made the best of her victory, by being First Veteran in the Flack Advisory Veterans Award, ahead of Mark Perdon & Bill Makeham, as well as first female in the Bendigo's Original Pie Shop Women's Award, clear of Lucy Booker & Lyn Crome.

The Liz & Mark Findlay Under 23 placings went to Jesse Noden in a good time of 30.20 minutes, ahead of Jessica O'Hara & Allan Colbert.

Jordan Doherty won the 1000 metre Children's Race for the second consecutive week, beating Daniel Noden in a dramatic finish, with Zac Watson in third place.

Fastest time was recorded by Will Noden in 3.34 minutes, with Demi Goodall-Hoffman, the fastest girl in 3.49 minutes.

Next Sunday is the 38th running of the Pro Dairy Australia Murchison 10km, starting at the Murchison Football Ground at 12 noon.

Up to 30 Bendigo Athletic Club members will take on about 40 Victorian Cross Country League (VCCL) runners from Melbourne in the classic 10000 metres race.



All athletes should have entered by now & should be reminded that there are no entries taken on the day.
