





MARK MAKES MINCE MEAT OF MAKEHAM & THE WOLF!

Mark Perdon has raced to a great victory in the Bendigo Athletic Club's longest race of the season, the Boundary Hotel 10000 metre Handicap, held at No.7

Reservoir at Crusoe Park in Kangaroo Flat.

Perdon ran a time of 43.45 minutes, stopping the clock, 22 seconds in front of Bill Makeham, with Wolf Heiden a further 62 seconds back in third place.

The top 3 placegetters, Perdon, Makeham & Heiden also took the maximum points in the Flack Advisory Veteran's Award.

Fastest Time of the day was recorded by Josh Sait in 35.42 minutes, ahead of Greg Hilson 37.01 & Brendan O'Brien 37.54.

Kerrieanne Hocking was fastest female on the course, recording a time of 44.58 minutes. Jessica O'Hara was next fastest female in 46.03, with Lyn Crome third best in 46.35 minutes. Gaining top points in the Bendigo's Original Pie Shop award for being the first female over the line was Rhonda Schultz, 21 seconds clear of Kerrieanne Hocking & Lyn Crome..

First place in the Liz & Mark Findlay Under 23 award was Jesse Noden, comfortably clear of Jessica O'Hara & Josh Sait.

The Children's 1000 metres was won by Madeleine Kleyn in 4.43, beating the previously undefeated Jordan Doherty, with Jaymin Boulton in third place

Fastest time was Tom Noden in 3.33 minutes, with the Fastest girl being Gabrielle Kleyn in 4.13 minutes.

After the day's events, 30 members returned to the venue of the day's sponsor, the Boundary Hotel for a well attended social lunch.

Next Sunday is the Rogan Family 6500 metre Handicap, to be held at Notleys Reserve, left off the Neilborough Road, Whipstick.



After two second placings in a row, Bill Makeham would have been considered favorite for next week's race, however, he is unable to run, leaving it open for several other competitors.

Wolf Heiden with a couple of minor placings this season, will be one of the better chances, as will Austin Beamish, Josh Nolan & Brendan O'Brien.

Jesse & Peter Noden will have a home ground advantage, but if you follow regular patterns, Mark Stevens won last week, Mark Perdon won this week, then Mark Findlay has to be favorite to win next week!

A Children's 1000 metre race will start at 10am, with the main event starting at 10.30am.
