



JESSICA CRUISES TO AGGREGATE WIN



The sealed handicap winner of the Bendigo Athletic Club's Cross Country season finale, the 'Flack Advisory' Dick Kitt 6500 metres was announced on Saturday night at the Club Presentation dinner at Bendigo's Famous Shamrock Hotel. Jessica O'Hara claiming a great victory by 20 seconds over Mark Perdon, then followed Doug Tuhan in third place, with Terry Crome & Adam Parker making up the top five.

The top five placegetters had bonus points added to their previous aggregate scores, with the winner receiving an Eaglehawk Cruise & Travel Award voucher valued at \$1,500.00.

With 30 points added for the winner of the final, Jessica O'Hara also claimed the aggregate award, ahead of Terry Crome & Doug Tuhan.

Terry Crome won the Gary Hogan Trophy for the top point scorer of the Club Run season with 137 points, ahead of Anthony Hutchison 136, followed by Peter LeBusque & Rhonda Schultz equal on 134 points

Josh Sait was announced as the Club Champion for 2012 with 58 points, ahead of Adam Parker 27 & Phil Noden 25.

Winner of the Bendigo's Original Pie Shop Award for the top women's point scorer was Rhonda Schultz, gaining 42 points, well clear of Jessica O'Hara 26, then a three way tie for third between Lyn Crome, Kathryn Heagney & Demi Goodall-Hoffman on 23 points.

Rhonda Schultz was also a clear winner of the Flack Advisory Veteran's Award finishing on 28 points, 11 clear of Anthony Hutchison on 17 & Peter LeBusque on 16 points.

Adam Parker was the winner of the Open age aggregate, over Scott Baxter & Ben Goode.

Long time club member Chook Stewart was presented with the Best Clubman award for the third time in the past 20 years.

Adam Parker was presented with the sort after 'Tool of the Year' Award by Chook Stewart for going the wrong way, on more than one occasion, on the same course during the season.
