

SLICK STEVE SLAUGHTERS SCHULTZ/STEWART RACE

First year runner, Steve Emonson has scored one of the biggest victories in recent years, recording a huge 62 second win the the Schultz/Stewart Landscape 6500 metre handicap in the Wellsford Forest in Bendigo on Sunday.



Emonson's time of 31.32 minutes for the 6.5km event was quicker than both of his 5km runs this season, meaning that no one would get near him.

Despite no seeing the winner, Chook Stewart finished in second place, with pre-race favorite Michael Preece in third place, with the fastest time of 21.43 minutes.

Second fastest time was Josh Sait at 21.46 minutes, ahead of veteran athlete Phil Noden 22.45 minutes.

Jessica O'Hara was the Fastest Female on the course, recording a time of 27.51 minutes, clear of Lyn Crome 31.38 & Anna Chatfield 34.38 minutes.

Chook Stewart topped the points in the Flack Advisory Veterans Award with Richard Schultz & Phil Noden, the next best.

Bendigo's Original Pie Shop Women's Handicap placings have been changing around each week, with Jessica O'Hara collecting the top points in this one, ahead of Lyn Crome & Rhonda Schultz.

Under 23's vying for the Liz & Mark Findlay award had Michael Preece, Jacob Nolan, & Jessica O'Hara filling the placings.

Erin Hilson scored a runaway win in the 1000 metres Children's Race, recording a personal best time of 4.01 minutes.

Second place went to Bree Heiden, who also claimed fastest time of 3.52, with Alice Bailey in third place.


