Fastest time honours this week again went with last year's Club Champion, Josh Sait in an impressive 35.42 minutes, ahead of Adam Parker in 36.29 minutes and Jacob Nolan third fastest in 37.35 minutes.



Stacey Clarkson was the Fastest Female on the course, recording a time of 41.28 minutes, ahead of Jessica O'Hara in 44.10 minutes & Rhonda Schultz in 59.13 minutes.

Clarkson took maximum points in the Bridge Hotel Open Award just ahead of Adam Parker and Ben Goode in third place.

Having a great day was Clarkson who also claimed first place in the Bendigo's Original Pie Shop Women's Award, ahead Jessica O'Hara & Rhonda Schultz.

Third placed overall, Jacob Nolan was the first under 23 athletes to finish & claimed the top points in the Liz & Mark Findlay award, ahead of Jessica O'Hara.

Alice Bailey cleaned up the kids race, winning from Jaymin Boulton & Connor Findlay, with Bree Heiden running the fastest time of 4.01 minutes
